

PLEASE NOTE:

Principals must submit a school calendar that includes (at least) 180 days (i.e., 177 instructional days and 3 conference days). Also, note that this calendar does not have a large number of snow days built into it. It is the suggestion of the Superintendent of Schools that the optional Mid-Winter Recess not be taken so that those days may be used in case of snow emergency.

In an effort to ensure as many instructional days as possible, the number of exam days in January and June should not be excessive. In January, school exam days should be scheduled to coincide with the Regents Exam days. In June, the school exam period should be two or three days before the Regents Exams begin.

VARIANCES FROM THE SUPERINTENDENT'S CALENDAR

Because of the need to communicate with contacts from New York State and New York City, as well as with various media, it is important for the Superintendent's Office to know when the schools in the Archdiocese are in session or not on any given day.

INCLEMENT WEATHER

Catholic schools in the Archdiocese of New York follow the policy of local public schools when closing due to inclement weather, loss of power or other issues.

In addition to following the lead of New York City public schools, Catholic schools in Staten Island, the Bronx and Manhattan may find it necessary to make closure decisions independently, based on local situations.

Schools in Westchester, Putnam and the Upper Counties that rely on public school districts for bus transportation will follow the delayed opening or closing policy of the local district.
