CATHOLIC HIGH SCHOOLS

**WHO**

Students in the eighth grade during the 2018-2019 school year wishing to apply for fall 2019 admission into Catholic high schools in the Archdiocese of New York and the Diocese of Brooklyn/Queens are eligible.

**WHEN**

**Archdiocese of New York: Friday, November 2, 2018**, at established test sites in Manhattan, Bronx, Staten Island, Westchester, Orange, Rockland, and Dutchess Counties.

**Diocese of Brooklyn/Queens: Saturday, November 3, 2018**, at test sites in Brooklyn and Queens.

**WHAT**

The test is designed to measure school aptitude and scholastic achievement in Reading, Mathematics, and Language.

**HOW**

Beginning August 20, you may register via the Internet at [www.tachsinfo.com](http://www.tachsinfo.com) or by telephone from 8:00 A.M. to 7:00 P.M. ET Monday–Friday and 10:00 A.M. to 2:00 P.M. ET Saturday–Sunday at **1-866-61TACHS** (1-866-618-2247). You may obtain a Student Handbook from a Catholic elementary or high school, religious education office or parish.
