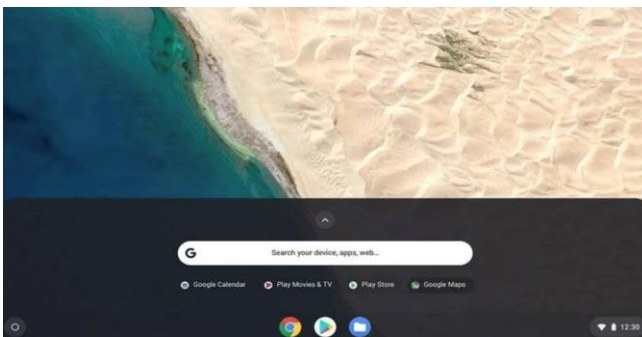
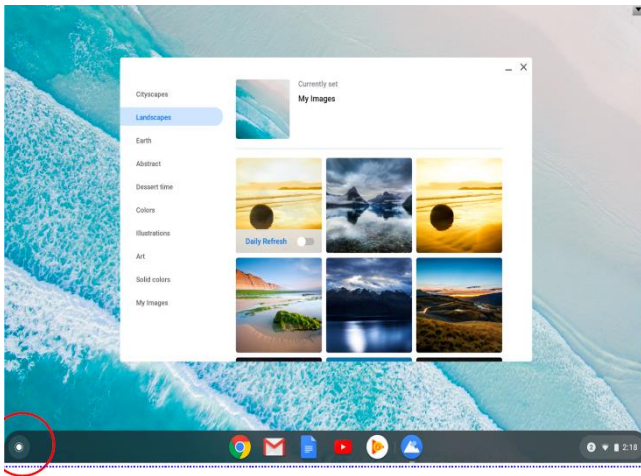




Download the Zoom App on Your Chromebook

In order to do so, follow the instructions below or [watch this short tutorial video](#):

- If your student's device is managed centrally by your school or the Archdiocese of New York, the Zoom App should already be downloaded on your Chromebook.
- Check if the app is already installed by clicking on the magnifying glass at the left corner of your Chromebook (red circle)
- When the window opens you can search for Zoom, by typing ZOOM, in the search area.



- If the see the Zoom App logo , there is nothing more you need to do. Zoom will automatically open when you click on the Zoom link in the Google Classroom.





If you DO NOT see a Zoom App, please keep following the steps below.

1. First, go to chrome.google.com/webstore
2. Search “Zoom” in the top left corner. Filter the results to Apps.
3. Choose the download the app from zoom.us.
4. Grant Zoom.us permission to download the app.
5. Click on your Home button on the Chromebook to see it installed.

Installing Zoom (iOS):

Tap on the Apple **App** Store icon on your **iOS** device to open.

1. Tap on Search at the bottom right of your screen.
2. Enter **Zoom** in the search text box.
3. Select **ZOOM** Cloud Meetings from the available **app** choices, and then tap on the GET button.
4. The install process will start.
5. Tap Open.
6. In the **Zoom app**, tap Sign In.
7. Sign in with your school account.

Installing Zoom (Android)

1. Tap on the Google Play Store icon.
2. In Google Play, tap on Apps.
3. In the Play Store screen, tap on the Search icon (magnifying glass) located at the top right-hand side of the screen.
4. Enter **zoom** in the search text area, and then tap **ZOOM** Cloud Meetings from the search results.
5. On the next screen, tap Install.
6. Find the Zoom App and Sign In with your school account.
