WHO IS FERRER?

- Ferrer enrollment is 375
- Average class has 24
- Ferrer students speak 40+ languages, live in 65 different neighborhoods all over the City
- Ferrer girls represent more than 100 grade schools within a radius of 40 miles
- In the last two graduating classes of Ferrer our seniors received \$31 million in the larger class, and \$26+ million [from a smaller class] in college scholarships
- Ferrer Class of '23 included National Merit Commended Scholar and two National Hispanic Recognition Program recipients
- Class of '24 [yet to be announced] includes 3 National Merit Commended Scholars [with the potential to be moved higher in the National Merit System]



WHO ARE OUR TEACHERS?

- Of the full time faculty at Ferrer 95% hold a Master's degree
- 25% of our teachers have earned more than one Master's Degree
- 3 have earned their PhD degrees
- The faculty is comprised of lay women and men, two Dominican Priests, and three Dominican Sisters

- Ferrer is a Catholic college preparatory school for girls, founded by the Dominican Sisters, members of the Dominican Order worldwide, committed to studying and finding the Truth [Veritas] and teaching it to others.
