As part of our ongoing process of the **School Viability Study** of Parish and Regional Elementary Schools in the Archdiocese of New York, it has been determined that **St. Mark the Evangelist School**, along with other beloved Catholic schools in the Archdiocese, will close at the end of the **2024-25 academic year**. This decision was made after extensive reflection, study, and prayer, as we face significant challenges that make it impossible to continue our mission at this location.

I know this news is heartbreaking. **St. Mark the Evangelist School** has been a cherished place of faith, learning, and love for generations, with a legacy of deep devotion to the education and formation of young hearts and minds. Please know that this decision was not made lightly—it was reached with great care for the future of Catholic education in New York.

Even in this difficult time, we must hold on to the belief that our mission continues. Catholic education remains strong and steadfast because we know the profound impact our schools have. Now more than ever, the world needs faith-filled leaders who emerge from our classrooms.

I want to assure you that **every child will have a place in another Catholic school**. St. Mark the Evangelist School in Manhattan will not reopen for the 2025-26 school year.

### What to Do Now

**1. Contact our Director of Enrollment for St. Mark the Evangelist School:**

Mr. Christopher Quito and his colleagues will work to help you and your child(ren) transition to another Catholic school for the 2025-26 school year.

**2. Learn more about the schools you are considering:**

- Contact your Director of Enrollment, who will help you review alternative schools and select the one that best fits your needs.
- Mr. Quito will also advise you on how to arrange a call or tour with the Principal of any school(s) you may be considering, to ensure that you have all the necessary information to make an informed choice for your family.
- Check this page often for new or updated information.

**3. Apply to the school where you want to send your children.**

- Once you have selected a school, simply visit: <https://admissions.catholicschoolsny.org> to submit your application. You will be required to set up a new FACTS login for the school to which you wish to apply.
- **We are committed to ensuring that your child can continue receiving a quality Catholic education.** Your Director of Enrollment will assist you in this transition and help identify an appropriate school where your child can enroll for the 2025-2026 school year. We will work with you to ensure that your child has a seat at another Catholic school.

- Families are required to submit a new application and register at the new school for the 2025-2026 school year to hold a seat for their child(ren) at the new school. Families who enroll at a participating school before April 15, 2025 will save \$100/student in registration fees. In addition, they will receive a credit to reimburse them for the entire registration fee in their November 2025 tuition invoice at their participating school.

- All families – including those not previously receiving assistance – will have a chance to apply for financial assistance as part of their application to a new participating school.

### **1. Why will my school not be reopening?**

We understand that this is upsetting news, and that you may feel there could have been something more you or your school community might have done. As part of the recently conducted School Viability Study (SVS), careful deliberation, research, and analysis went into the final determination of which schools would not reopen. Unfortunately, the demographics and lower enrollment have significantly impacted the ability for these schools to continue operation.

### **2. Will I have to re-apply to the new school?**

Families whose schools are not reopening are required to submit a new application and register at a different Catholic school for the 2025-2026 school year to hold a seat for their child(ren) at the new school. Once you have selected a school, simply visit <https://admissions.catholicschoolsny.org> and submit your application.

### **3. If my school is closing, will I have to register at the new school?**

Yes. In order to complete enrollment at your new school, you will have to register your child(ren) and pay the applicable registration fee. If you register at a participating school before April 15, 2025, you will save \$100/student in registration fees. In addition, you will receive a credit to reimburse you for the entire registration fee in your November, 2025 tuition invoice at participating schools.

**4. Will my tuition costs go up if the new school's tuition is higher than at my current school?**

The Archdiocese of New York is committed to making every effort to minimize the financial impact to your family as a result of this transfer.

All families – including those not previously receiving assistance – will have a chance to apply for financial assistance as part of their application to a new participating school.

**5. Who do I turn to for help?**

Your Regional Director of Enrollment will help you and your child(ren) transition to another Catholic school for the 2025-2026 school year. You can reach your Regional Director of Enrollment at the email address indicated above for your school, or by calling our bilingual parent helpline at (646) 794-2885 between 9:00 and 5:00 pm Monday-Friday.

**6. How do I learn more about other nearby schools that would meet my child's needs?**
