Reflection and Story about Pope Francis

Leader:

Pope Francis was a great Pope who loved Jesus and loved people. He worked hard to make the world a better place, especially for those who were suffering. One thing Pope Francis often told us was that we should be kind and compassionate toward others, just as Jesus was kind and compassionate to us. He also reminded us to care for the poor and the sick and to live out our faith every day through small acts of kindness.

(Leader may insert a short story about Pope Francis)

Story:

When Pope Francis was in Argentina, he helped the poor people on the streets by visiting them and bringing them food. He said, 'When we help others, we are helping Jesus.' Even when he became Pope, he continued to visit people in need and show love to all, no matter who they were or where they came from.

Moment of Silence

Leader:

Now, let's take a moment of silence to pray for Pope Francis. Let's thank God for his life and ask God to give him eternal rest. We also ask God to help us live like Pope Francis by being kind, loving, and serving others.

(All join in 30-60 seconds of quiet prayer.)

- 3. We pray for the poor and sick, that they feel God's love."
- 4. We pray for our Church, that it continues to help others, just like Pope Francis did.
- 5. We pray for all our intentions within our hearts.

Leader:

Let us pray for these intentions, and for everyone who is sad today, that they feel God's peace.
